Services Provided

During the last fiscal year, Senior Assistance Center continued to promote the self-sufficiency of senior citizens in Denver by providing a resource for basic necessities during times of hardship.

In the last year, Senior Assistance Center:

- Distributed emergency food and supplies to 278
- Kept utilities on in 113 households
- Provided clothing to 114
- Provided free medical equipment to 25
- Provided 39 reduced fare monthly RTD passes
- Assisted 57 with CARE and LEAP applications
- Provided free computer-printer-phone access to 40
- Provided information & referrals to 1,539
- Started a free senior library
- Provided holiday gifts to 68
- Provided Valentine food boxes to 24

We partnered with the following organizations to provide more comprehensive services: Dress for Success Denver, Rebuilding Together Metro Denver, Bienvenidos Food Bank, Jefferson Avenue United Methodist Church
