Services Provided

During the last fiscal year, Senior Assistance Center continued to promote the self-sufficiency of senior citizens in Denver by providing a resource for basic necessities during times of hardship.

In the last year, Senior Assistance Center:

- Distributed emergency food and supplies to 707
- Kept utilities on in 134 households
- Provided clothing to 95
- Provided free medical equipment to 26
- Provided 79 reduced fare monthly RTD passes
- Assisted 87 with CARE and LEAP applications
- Provided free computer-printer-phone access to 46
- Provided information & referrals to 1,679
- Provided a free senior library
- Provided holiday gifts to 88
- Provided Valentine food boxes to 24
